THE STORY

On 13 July 1985, **Live Aid** reached nearly two billion people — a single broadcast that turned compassion into a global event. **We were heroes, for one day.** Solidarity that lasts a day changes a moment; solidarity that lasts generations changes the world. Stars Align exists to carry that spirit forward — not as a concert, but as a living, global classroom.

One crisis became *seventeen*.

The world that gathered for one cause in 1985 now faces many at once — and the divide between us is widening, not closing.

Division and conflict are deepening. Hunger, inequality and a changing climate compound one another — codified by the UN as 17 Sustainable Development Goals. The call that once rang out for a single emergency now rings out seventeen times at once.

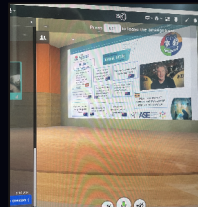

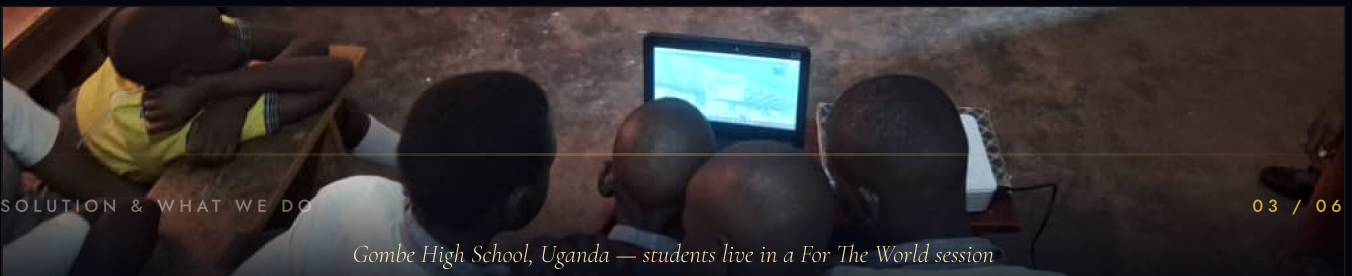

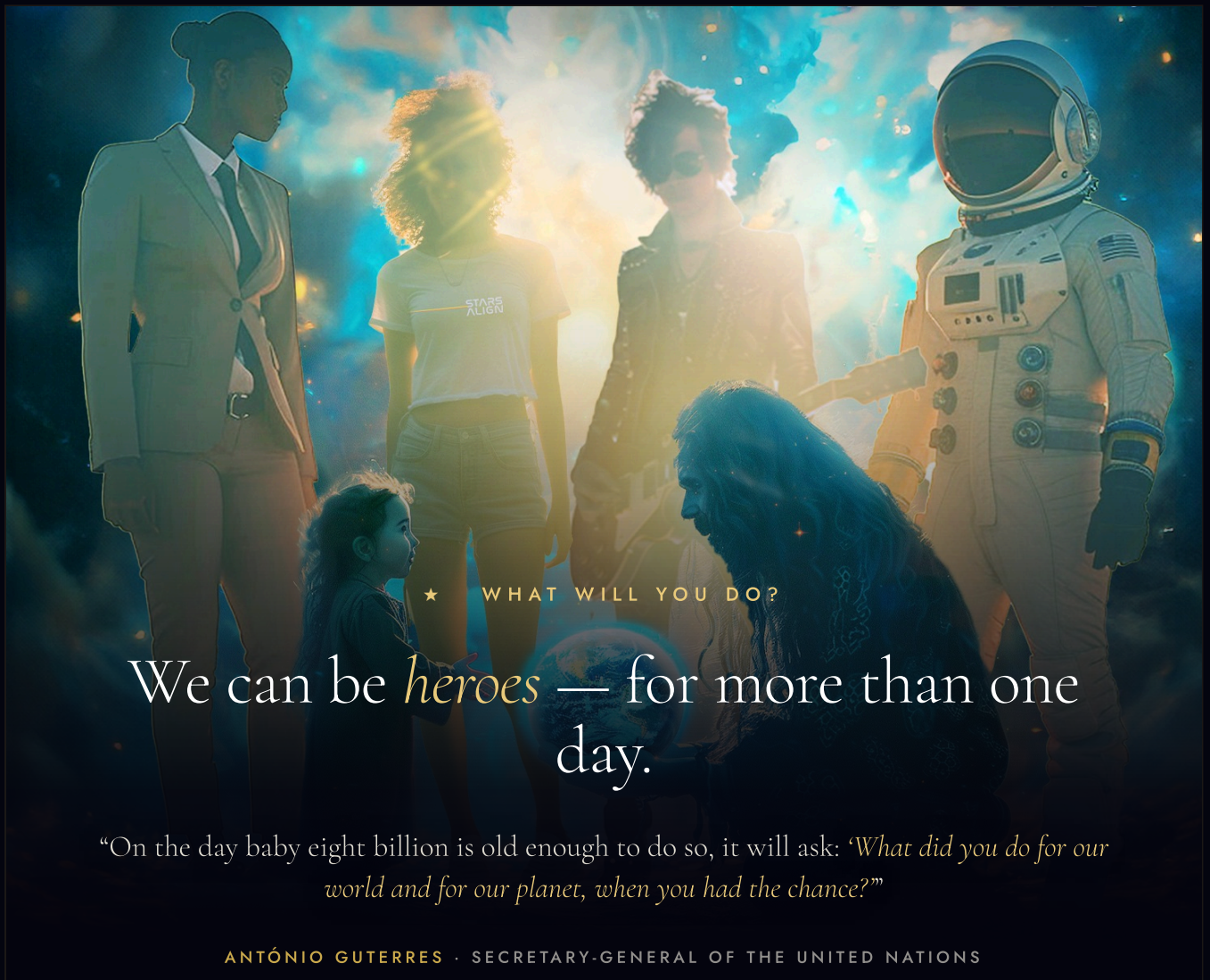
YOUR TERMS
